- Play by the laws of the game of Rugby.
- Enjoy the game of Rugby and help others do the same.
- Support good sportsmanship, we want to nurture this habit.
- Control your temper – no “mouthing off”.
- Do not ridicule or abuse young players, they are trying to learn.
- Do not criticise club / team officials, offer to help out, you may enjoy the experience.
- Co-operate with your coach, team-mates, referees and opponents, for without them you do not have a game.
