By representing yourself in an honest manner, you will endeavour to uphold the following to the best of your ability:

- Be a good sport applauding good play by all participants and respecting the decision of Match Officials and coaches.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from the game, including the use of foul language.
- 3. Accept that everyone makes mistakes. Do not ridicule or yell at players, coaches or Match Officials for perceived mistakes.
- Respect and comply with directions given by the Ground Marshall, who is there to ensure a safe and enjoyable Rugby experience is had by all.
- Comply with any Conditions of Entry to the venue, including staying out of the playing enclosure during the game.
- Make visitors feel welcome when your team plays at home, and be a gracious and respectful guest when your team play away.
